Hello all...

Since my last writing about COVID-19 the number of cases has diminished fortunately, and perhaps thanks to a mild winter we have not had any new cases in three weeks. There are still small numbers of cases in the community, and certainly we do not think that the virus is unlikely to visit us again. Staff continues to work diligently on all aspects of Infection Control, and has done a terrific job of managing “outbreaks” when do they do occur. We continue to encourage everyone to stay home if you feel sick – cold, flu or COVID-19 – and to follow good Infection Control Guidelines.

Most all other aspects of our organization are busy and happily serving our community. There are a number of traditional events that are scheduled for this year that haven’t happened since 2019, such as the upcoming Centenarian Luncheon (which will honor 14 individuals who have reached this milestone), and the Family Day celebration organized by our Men’s Club in September. We look forward to all of these celebrations with you!

As we start to think about Spring, which is only one month away, I would also like to share a quick update about our development progress in Stamford. **Mozaic Concierge Living** has already made great strides towards the architectural design of the new campus on Long Ridge Road, and we expect to complete Schematic Design and the initial Interior Design, Landscaping and Civil Engineering work by mid-March. This will allow us to prepare and submit the Site Plan to Stamford Planning & Zoning. Simultaneously, we have launched our Priority Reservation Program, and begun a monthly luncheon education series to help communicate to prospective Residents what this new Life Plan (or CCRC) community will be like. Those on the Priority Reservation list will have first access to selecting specific residences and design features when they become available and the Sales Center opens later this year.
