Hello all...

Unfortunately, I must again report that there were 2 additional Residents and 5 staff members who tested positive for COVID-19 in the past week. We have done contact tracing on all impacted and this remains isolated in 2 households (and staff on the 2nd floor). We believe the initial contact was through a visitor, and we must continue to recognize that while the community prevalence is dramatically lower it is clearly not gone. Please continue to respect the Infection Control Guidelines, and wear your face coverings, wash your hands, etc.

We are working on the implementation of the 2nd booster shot for Residents and staff that are eligible. The guidelines from the CDC regarding a second mRNA COVID-19 booster dose (Pfizer or Moderna) are as follows:

- If you received a booster of either Pfizer or Moderna at least 4 months ago;
- If you received J&J as both your primary vaccine and booster at least 4 months ago;
- Are ages 50 years and older; or
- Are moderately or severely immunocompromised; ages 12 years and older and received any booster dose at least 4 months ago.

We certainly encourage everyone who is eligible to receive this booster shot ASAP.
