Hello all...

The community trend in COVID-19 cases continues to see a reduction in cases and hospitalizations in our region. In the past 2 weeks (since my last Update) there have been 2 Resident and 6 staff cases of COVID-19. We continue to do all that we can to protect everyone, and appreciate all of your efforts to comply with Federal and State guidelines.

We are starting our weekly Resident BBQs next week, and they will continue each Wednesday for 12 weeks through the summer – 1 floor per week. Unfortunately, by Federal Guidelines we must continue to restrict these outings to Residents this year. We also have hired a bus driver (finally) to enable us to restart community trips for Residents as well. We have scheduled a visit thanks to the Men's Club for Residents to go to Citifield on August 10th.
