Hello all...

Since my last Update, there continue to be a small number of Resident and staff cases of COVID-19, as well as a meaningful prevalence in the community. In the first few weeks of July, there have been only 4 Resident and 7 staff cases reported. Obviously we remain concerned about the spread of the virus and its virulent variants.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) also expanded its recommendations for the vaccine to include children ages 6 months to 5 years, which is good news for those with younger children. “Vaccinating everyone ages 6 months and older is the best defense against serious illness, hospitalization and death related to COVID-19” according to the CDC.
